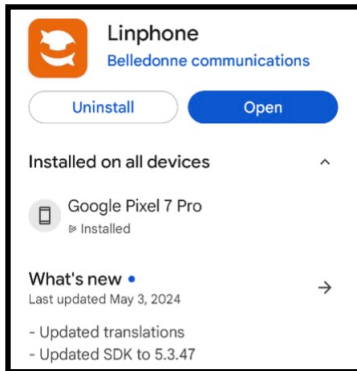
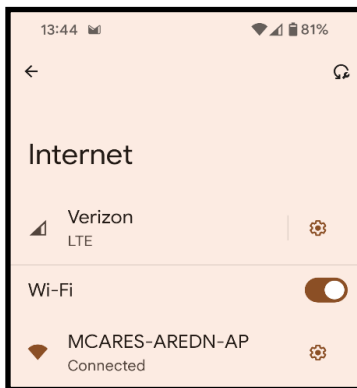


Setting up Linphone Account on Android Devices



Go to the App Store

Download Linphone App from Google Play Store



Connect Your Wifi to: MCARES-AREDN-AP
(Password will be provided by Chip N0WRK,
Bill K0DZ, or Steve KE0BPD)

Open the Linphone App

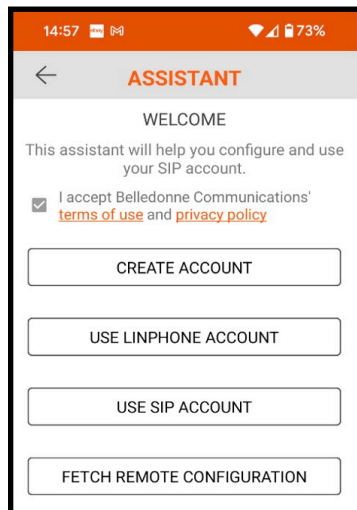
You will have multiple windows popping up asking for permissions:

Allow Microphone - Allow

Allow Notifications - Allow

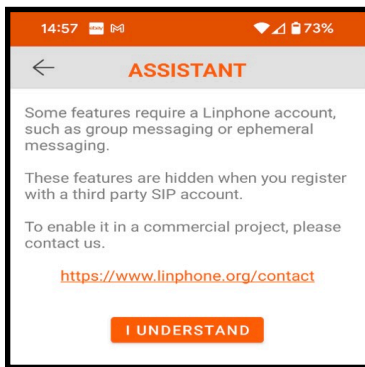
Allow Photos - Up to you

DO NOT Allow Contacts (these are your cellphone contacts)

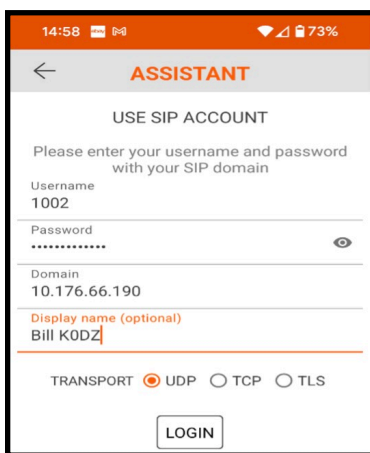


Click on **ASSISTANT** and then check to accept terms of use.

Click **USE SIP ACCOUNT**



On the ASSISTANT page, click **I UNDERSTAND**



Username = phone number provided by Bill K0DZ

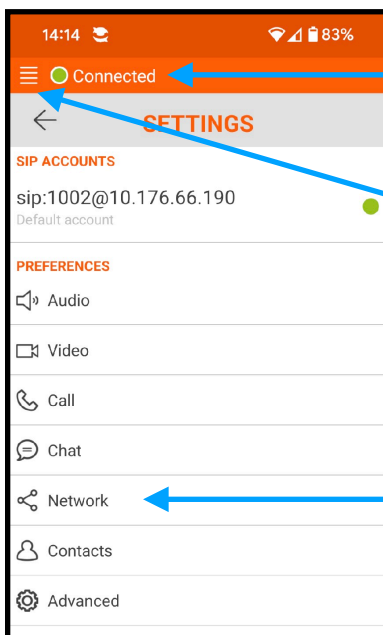
Password = PBX password provided by Bill K0DZ

Domain = 10.176.66.190

Display Name (optional) = You can put in whatever you wish to use. For example: Callsign - Name)

For **TRANSPORT** select **UDP**

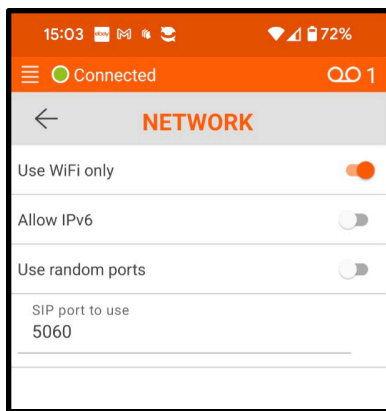
Click **LOGIN**



At this point the dot in the upper left may show **CONNECTING**, **CONNECTION FAILED**, or **CONNECTED**

Regardless, you must continue setting up Linphone by clicking on the 4 horizontal bars in the upper lefthand corner of the screen and selecting the **SETTINGS** page

Under **PREFERENCES**, Click on **Network**



Click **Use Wifi only**
Unclick **Allow IPv6**
Unclick **Use random ports**
Make sure **SIP port to use** is set to **5060**

The dot next to **Connected** should now magically turn green.
(If it doesn't turn green, recheck that you are WiFi connected to MCARES-AREDN-AP)

Voilà! You are connected!
